Swedish applicants are also required to complete a separate application at the SEM website in addition to the full consortium application in the NERapplication portal (See link below).

- Eligible cost: 1. personnel costs of maximum of 825 SEK per hour (no limit for universities); 2. costs for equipment, land and buildings to the extent and during the time they are used for the project; 3. costs for consultants 4. licenses with certain limitations 5. other indirect costs 6. overhead of maximum of 30% of other costs (full cost principle applied for universities) Further details are available in Swedish see link below.
