Objective of the study

- Detailed description of the aggregation models selected by independent aggregators in different European countries for different marketplaces
- Can lessons be drawn for the Nordic context?
 - Common model for the Nordic countries: advantages and disadvantages?

Content of the study

- Description of the regulation concerning aggregation in Belgium, Finland, France, Germany, the Netherlands, Switzerland and Great Britain
 - Interviews with market parties, DSOs/TSOs and NRAs in the relevant countries
- Look at the Nordic countries: what is common, what are the differences
 - Will the same model(s) fit in all the Nordic countries?
 - How can we build on existing cooperation (eSett etc)?
