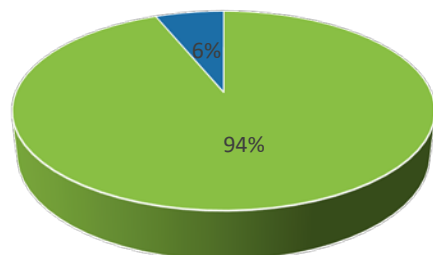

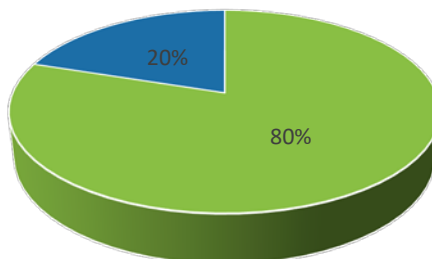

Programs in the years 2007 – 2010



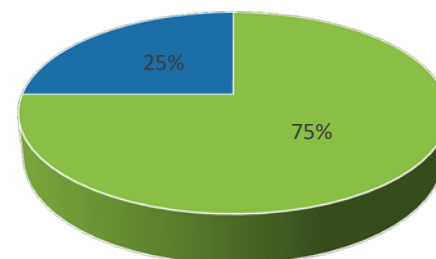
■ male ■ female

Program, SES 2050 (2011 – 2015)



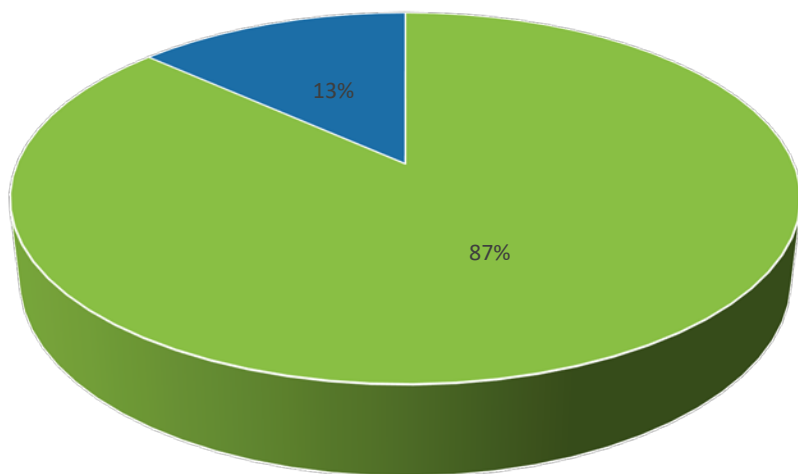

Flagship projects - since 2015



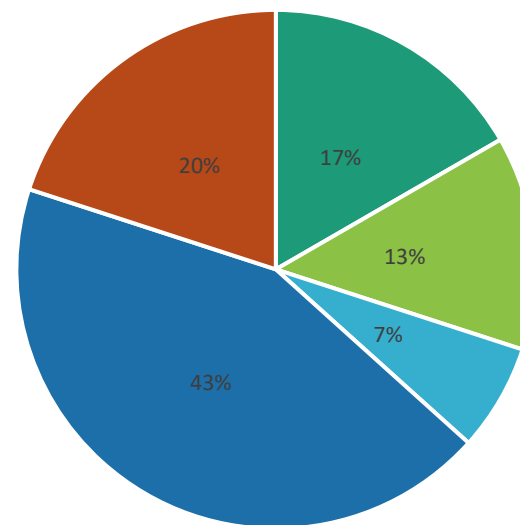

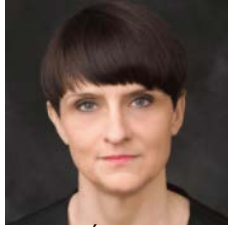

Networking in Iceland



- In February 2000 a female board within the Engineering association was created
- Couple of years later a group calling itself Stuðverk (Funeng) emerged but has been dormant
- In January 2016 Konur í orkumálum (KÍO Women in energymatters) was founded
- Samtök kvenna í vísindum (SKVÍS) is a network of women in science and was founded in February 2016
